SPECIAL NOTE:

This is a single bundle procurement solicitation. The machine is to be quoted individually (including options included and respective pricing), but selection and procurement will be for all pieces of equipment combined. Equipment will not be procured individually.

CDL Simulator

- L3 Driver Simulator
- Triple screens included, with setup
- Manual Transmission Add-on
- CDL Schools Scenario Package
- Motion Platform
- Includes freight and onsite installation and training
- Manufacturers must guarantee critical component and part access for a minimum of 3 years. This includes factory calibrated and matching tiles and modules.
- Vendor must assemble the product on site for customer.
- Vendor supplier must provide necessary rigging for product.
- Vendor suppliers must provide adequate insurance for the product install, product damage coverage and customer damage if items are broken upon install.

Selection Criteria

All the above specifications will be included in evaluation of vendor proposals. Specific priority will be given to the following areas:

- Cost 40%
- Build Volume 10%



- Durability/reliability/warranty of the above subsystems in a typical operating environment 25%
- Customer references 5%
- Educational discount 20%
